THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That whereas the above bounden William Erving both made application for a License for Marriage, to be celebrated between him and Elizabeth Allison of the county aforesaid: Now in case it shall not hereafter appear that there is any lawful cause or impediment to obstruct said Marriage, then the above obligation to be void—otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
