TO ANY OBTAINED MINISTER OF ANY RELIGIOUS DENOMINATION OR ANY JUSTICE OF THE PEACE OF SAID COUNTY:

Geo. S. Fultz having applied to me for a **LICENSE** for the Marriage of Geo. S. Fultz of Surry Co. N.C. aged 26 years, color white the son of Lehman Fultz and Mrs. A. Fultz the father now deceased the mother living resident of Surry Co. N.C.

And Louisa E. Denny of Surry Co. N.C. aged 16 years, color white daughter of A. W. Denny and Louisa Denny the father living the mother deceased resident of Surry Co. N.C.

And the written consent of A. W. Denny the Father of the said L. E. Denny in the proposed marriage having been filed with me.

And there being no legal impediment to such marriage known to me, you are hereby authorized, at any time within one year from the date hereof, to celebrate the proposed marriage at any place within the said county.

You are required, within two months after you shall have celebrated such marriage, to return this License to me, at my office, with your signature subscribed to the certificate under this License, and with the blanks therein filled according to the facts, under penalty of forfeiting two hundred dollars to the use of any person who shall sue for the same.
